

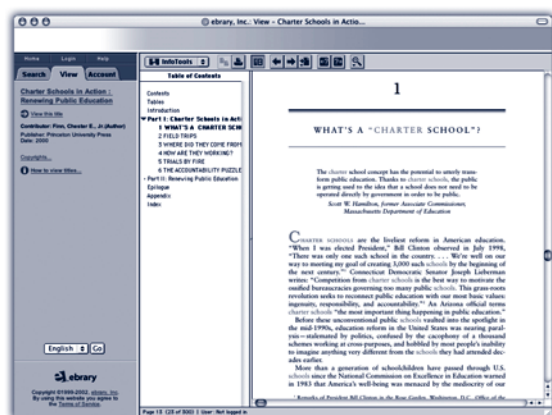

COLLECTION OVERVIEW

ebrary's Social & Behavioral Sciences collection spans the full range of social science disciplines, from anthropology to political science to social work. It also includes a comprehensive category in education and a significant offering in psychology.

At over 1,500 applicable book titles, the education category treats all aspects of the field, including administration, assessment, curricula, multiculturalism, reform, pedagogy, and technology. It supports both undergraduate and graduate curricula in education degree programs and offers a complete reference library for instructors and administrators.

The political science category is headed by Cambridge University Press, voted the field's most important publisher by the American Political Science Association, but also a number of public policy think tanks such as American Enterprise Institute and RAND Corporation. With strengths in civil rights, international relations, law, political economy, and public policy, ebrary's offering in political science supports curricula across a range of disciplines.

Covering the sub-fields of psychology, the collection offers many titles applicable to course work and research in addictions, depression, interpersonal relations, personality, psychiatry, and psychotherapy. Complementing the education category, this cluster also includes several titles in child

development, cognitive science, and the treatment of conditions such as ADHD, autism, OCD, and other learning disabilities.

Students and researchers engaged in the study of ethnic groups, gender, marriage and family, religion, sexuality, and other social phenomena will find useful monographic and reference volumes throughout ebrary's broader Social & Behavioral Sciences collection.
